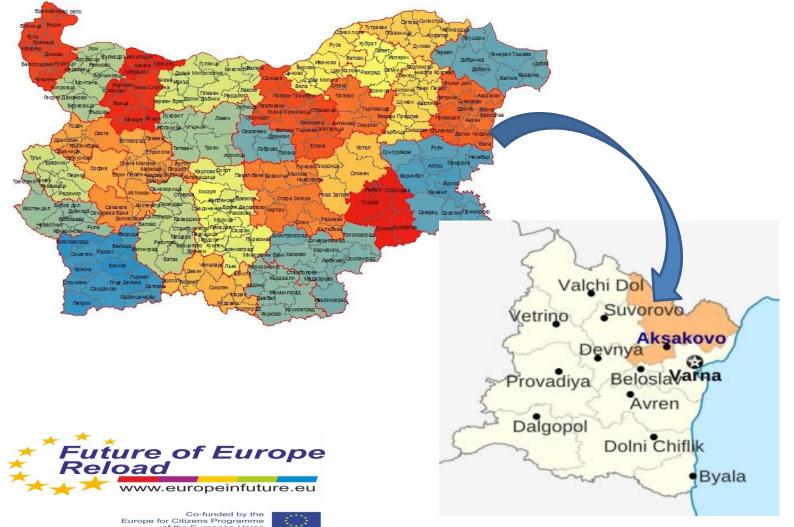

Location of Aksakovo Municipality







- * 21 % of population are people up to 19 ages;
- * 3 % of people up to 19 ages are people with disadvantages;
- * 5 % of people above 19 ages are people with disadvantages;
- * 18 % of population are people above 65 ages /elders/;



Main priorities of the social policy at local level

- * Support people with disadvantages /children and elders/
- * Social inclusion for minorities



- From 2007 to 2017 Aksakovo municipality implemented 5
 projects to improve the quality of life of people from
 the vulnerable groups and 2 projects for social inclusion
 of minorities:

- Establishment of a municipal social enterprise Home Social Patronage in the municipality of Aksakovo;
- Support for Independent Living;
- - Warm Lunch;

The project completed in December 2017. Within the project 68 people were concerned: 33 out of 68 had a personal assistant and 35 had a home assistant.

Purpose of the Project:

- To present the active and healthy lifestyle as a base for better quality of life and to show the possibilities of attracting people to daily sports and practicing different types of sports.

Within the project 2 competitions will take place. Each of them consists of 5 sport disciplines. They are intended for people over 60. At the end of the project, the collected information at European level is going to be presented in order to create a strategy to promote the sport activity.







Activities:

- 1. Practicing physical exercise twice a week for people over 60;
- 2. Holding Olympic Games 2 times within the project;
- 3. Test participants every 6 months to track changes in physical exercise.
